- Marine Sciences Seminar (FHL 490, 1 credit)
- Research in Marine Biology (FHL 470, 6 credits)
Students engage in an individual or small-group research project mentored by scientists.

What's Friday Harbor Labs?

It's a UW marine station located along the quiet shores of San Juan Island, 80 miles northwest of UW Seattle campus.

Where will I live during the quarter?

You'll live in FHL dorm rooms or huts, and eat your meals in the FHL Dining Hall.

How much does the program cost?

UW students pay the same tuition as in Seattle! Other expenses are lab fees plus FHL dorm housing & meal plan at prices comparable to UW Seattle. Mary Gates Endowment (MGE) Research Scholarships are available to qualified students enrolled in FHL 470.
