Scholarship Announcement

The Scholarship Committee of the Northwest Horticultural Society is pleased to announce the **2018 Elisabeth Carey Miller Scholarship**. The scholarship is open to students enrolled in the **graduate program at the Center for Urban Horticulture** at the **University of Washington** or in programs at the UW associated with the Center, such as the **School of Environmental and Forest Sciences** and the **Department of Landscape Architecture**.

The intent is to support the efforts of a student with a project or goal related to environmental horticulture. The source of the funds is from the interest accrued from the Northwest Horticultural Society Horticultural Education Fund, a \$150,000 endowment.

This scholarship is not intended as a full scholarship but as financial assistance for a specific project. The applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee of the NHS, which consists of an acting chair from the NHS board and three other members appointed by the Scholarship Committee chair.

In **2018** there will be one scholarship for **\$3,000**, with the possibility of an additional scholarship of a lesser amount being awarded to another student.

Information regarding the eligibility requirements and application procedures for the scholarship is attached. **The application deadline is November 7, 2018**. Please share this information with your faculty and students.

Thank you for assisting us in offering scholarship support to students who are working towards future careers in urban horticulture and related disciplines.
