A UW marine station located along the quiet shores of San Juan Island, 80 miles northwest of UW Seattle campus.

How much does the program cost?

UW students pay the same tuition as in Seattle! Other expenses are course fees, plus FHL dorm housing and meal plan at prices comparable to UW Seattle. Students may apply for financial assistance from FHL.
