A UW marine station located along the quiet shores of San Juan Island, 80 miles northwest of UW Seattle campus.

Where will I live during the quarter?

In FHL dorm rooms or huts, with meals served in the FHL Dining Hall.

How much does the program cost?

UW students pay the same tuition as in Seattle! Other expenses are course fees, plus FHL dorm housing and meal plan comparable in price to UW Seattle. Mary Gates Research Scholarships are available to qualified UW students.
