Project Description & Duties:

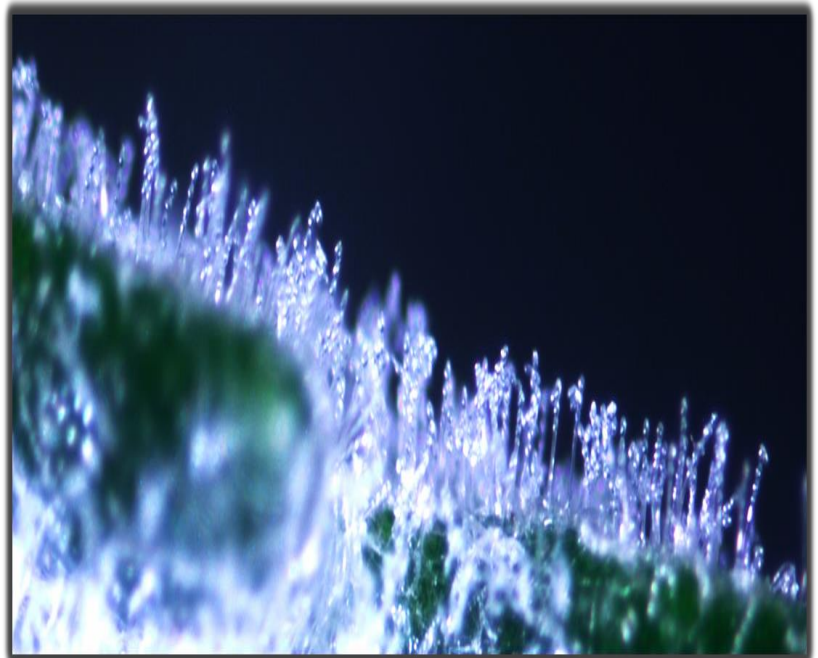
We will be evaluating powdery mildew species accruing on the UW campus, including the Washington State Arboretum. The selected students will have the opportunity to compile a comprehensive database, gain experience using microscopes and creating phylogenetic trees, and conduct lab work prepping DNA to be sequenced (PCR).
